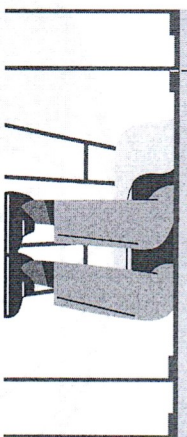
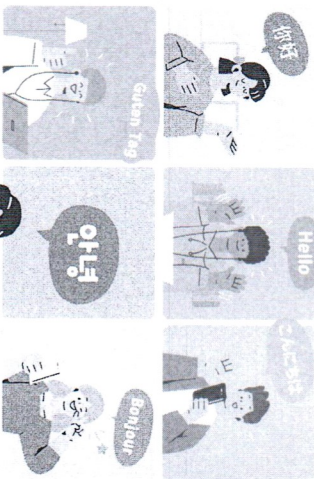

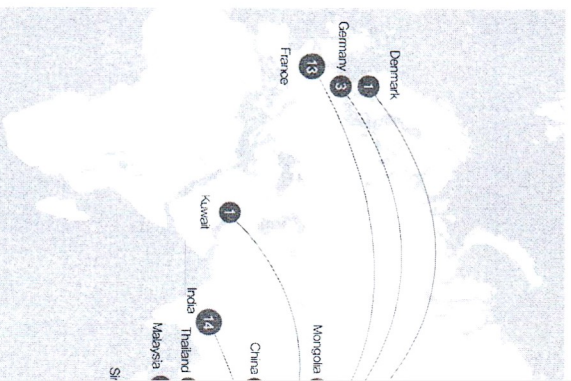

## The whole world as one online in International Joint Class



### What is International Joint Class?

Schools in Seoul and abroad interact through remote classes on an online platform to allow students to learn other languages and cultures and get to know friends from various backgrounds.

### Purpose

Cultural and emotional exchanges to strengthen global competency and build friendships

### Class Management

After matching a Seoul-based school to a school abroad, the two schools will discuss class details.

Category	Topic-type, subject, class	Speaking in the counterpart country's language	Non-lect-type remote class
Class Platform	Zoom, etc.		
Participating Countries	Countries with little time difference from Korea (Japan, New Zealand, Australia, China, etc.)	Countries with greater time differences from Korea (The U.S., European countries, etc.)	
Languages Used	(Mother tongue, counterpart country's language, English, etc. as agreed with the counterpart)		
Class Management	Classes conducted based on the discussion between the teachers from the two sides on class topics, schedule, etc. * Class topics and manual will be provided		
Others	Interpretation/translation programs for virtual meetings can be used, if necessary (https://class.sen.go.kr/)		

### Who are remote class assistants?

This program translates what you say in your mother tongue into the counterpart country's language, helping students with little foreign language skills participate in class without stress.

## Process for International Joint Class



### Office of Education | School Tie-up Procedure

1. Request survey / Counterpart country
  2. School Tie-up (March - November)
  3. Notification of the tie-up result (December - February)
- Collection of International Joint Class applications from schools in Korea and abroad
  - Factoring in language grade quota, time, etc.
  - Provide both tie-up schools with the counterpart's information

### School | Class Procedure

1. Preparation
  2. Roll call
  3. Class time
  4. Overseeing class activities
  5. Class wrap up
  6. Homework assignments
- Discussion on class schedule, topic, etc. between the teacher's from tie-up schools
  - Access the platform and check attendance
  - Brief self-introduction followed by the lecture and activities
  - Help from remote class assistants (optional)
  - Check on group rooms and encourage student participation
  - Return to the main screen and wrap-up
  - Share feedback and thoughts on the class
  - Interactions through "culture boxes", letter writing, social media, e-mail, etc.

### Who are remote class assistants?

Volunteer language assistants for study who provide interpretation/translation for a smooth running of International Joint Class and assist with class activities.
